

Something ROTTEN DIRECTORS' NOTES

In 2016, we were fortunate to travel to NYC at the same time and got "rush" tickets to *SOMETHING ROTTEN* with the original Broadway cast. We immediately started discussing how the show would remain at the top of our possible show list until we could produce it with our students. For three years on and off, we've communicated with the publishing company requesting to be a pilot school for a high school version, requesting to be on any kind of early notification list, and on and on annoying them any way we could to get to do this show as soon as possible.

Fast forward to the summer of 2019 when we learned that the *SR* rights were going to come available. Again, we contacted our licensing rep requesting to announce as soon as we could, understanding rights were pending. We opened the school year letting our Tiger Drama community that we were changing the season to accommodate producing this show. What many don't realize is that announcement was followed by learning that there were issues with the materials and the distribution and we would not be able to audition in December as originally planned. The entire season was reconfigured again because of the educational and entertainment value of this show.

Now, here we are. In Co-Vid "lockdown". Not rehearsing, not seeing each other, and not making art together. Our hearts are broken but we are determined to find a way to honor the hard work and dedication that has been put into this production by our students and production team. Watch for updates and please join us in believing you'll see these amazing students and their great work!
