- 2. All applicants must show a proven history of skill level and a passion for continued growth and moving to the next level.
- 3. All applicants will be current Lewis and Clark High School 9th-11th graders.
- 4. All applicants acknowledge that any recorded media or photos may be used for additional marketing materials for STAGE or LC Tiger Drama.
- 5. All applicants will request a letter of recommendation from a mentor/coach/teacher who can speak to the student's work ethic/perseverance/skill/willingness to work toward goals, etc.
