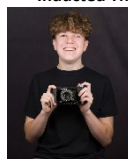

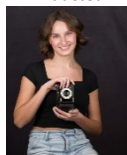

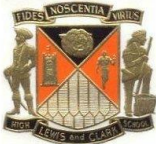
## ***Costume Designer***

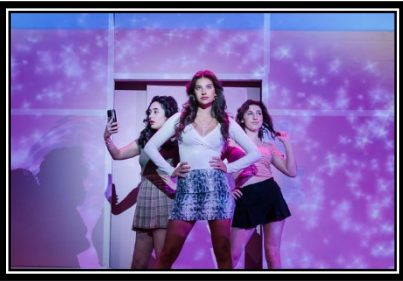
