BEGINNING THEATRE

Grades 9-12

No extra-curricular requirements.

Our Beginning Theatre class gives you confidence as you learn & develop acting skills & gain a general knowledge of theatre and public speaking. This is a group activity class in which all students take an active part & will perform in front of class periodically.

INTERMEDIATE THEATRE

Grades 9-12 - For students with previous performance experience.

Intermediate Theatre is designed for students with previous experience who want to further develop their acting skills. Special emphasis is directed to scene study, script analysis & performances. This is a group activity class in which all students take an active part & perform in class.

0 Hour Class - CTE Credit - Grades 10-12

Stagecraft is a hands-on class in which participants actively explore & create elements for the many technical areas of theater including lighting, sound, makeup, set design, costumes, publicity, and stage management.
