

DIRECTOR'S NOTES

Twelve Angry Jurors takes us into the intense and confined space of a jury room, where twelve individuals from diverse backgrounds must deliberate the fate of a young man accused of murder. The pressure cooker environment of the jury room serves as the perfect backdrop for exploring timeless themes of justice, prejudice, and the power of human empathy.

Some may be familiar with the original title *Twelve Angry Men* and the 1957 or 1997 film versions. Reginald Rose's original script has been adapted multiple times since its original airing on live television in 1954. Adaptations include an all-female version, *Twelve Angry Women*, as well as modern adaptations with updated language for modern settings. The adaptations also allow for more variations in casting using the title *Twelve Angry Jurors*. Our Tiger Drama production uses the first stage adaptation based on the original teleplay.

Setting the production 1963 gave us an opportunity to use student dramaturgs who researched and provided valuable information for the actors to consider in the analysis and character development process. Mara Bech and Isabella Maxwell, our dramaturgs, created an informative presentation that included facts about the fashion of the late 50's – early 60's, the political and cultural climates of the time, as well as a fascinating timeline of which wars may have influenced specific jurors. The rehearsal process for this show was demanding for our students and I could not be prouder of their adjustment to this unique performance setting.




