

SYNOPSIS

All four lovers end up chasing each other through the woods. Meanwhile, a group of amateur actors, led by Piper Quince, head to the forest to rehearse a play for the Duke's wedding. In the same forest, fairy royalty Oberon and Titania are feuding. Oberon enlists his mischievous servant the Pucks to use a magic flower to cause love chaos—but the Pucks mistakes only add to the mayhem.
